I RACE OBJECTIVES

- Popularization of cross-country cycling in the municipality of Jezewo and the county of Swiecie as a healthy form of recreation and a way of life.
- Promotion of outdoor movement and sports of children and young people.
- Promotion of Swiecie County and Kujawsko-Pomorskie Voivodeship.
- Scoring points for the Polish Cup and Challenge classification of PZKol and UCI ranking (in the Elite M+W category, Junior M+W category).

III DATE AND LOCATION

The race will take place on November 15, 2025 (Saturday) in Laskowice Pomorskie, 48 Dluga Street.

IV GENERAL INFORMATION

Licensed participants must be registered on the website: https://wynikizawodow.eu/cx_owocowyprzelaj by 13.11.2025 to 18:00. Participants are asked to collect their competition numbers and verify documents on 14.11.2025 between 17.00 do 20.00 and on the day of the competition at the competition office from 7:30 until 1 hour before the start of a given category. Competitors taking part in the last race can collect their start numbers by 12:00 (AM). The competition office is in Dom Misyjny ksiezy Werbistow (the Missionary House of the Verbist Fathers), Dluga 44 Street in Laskowice Pomorskie.

Applications for Amateur category competitors are conducted also exclusively through the website: https://wynikizawodow.eu/cx_owocowyprzelaj until 13.11.2025 until 18:00 or on the day of the competition at the organiser's office at 8:00-9:30. Note: limited number of competitors: 110. Unlicensed riders (18 years and older) are eligible to compete. The organiser's office is in Dom Misyjny ksiezy Werbistow (the Missionary House of the Verbist Fathers), Dluga 44 Street in Laskowice Pomorskie. The locker room for competitors is also located in Dom Misyjny.

Special 16 starting places: **VIP Amateur** (2 first lines x 8 competitors). Positioning on the first 2 starting lines according to the order of payment at registration. All proceeds of the VIP Amateur will go to charity.

After finishing the race, the chip (worn on the left ankle, placed on the outside) must be returned at the competition office. A chip not returned (on the day of the race) or damaged is subject to a fee of 100 PLN. Starting numbers are also returnable at the competition office, except for the Amateur category.

V RACE RULES

- 1. Participants registered with a sports club with a valid license for 2025 and who have current medical examination are eligible to participate.
- 2. The competition will be held in accordance with UCI and PZKol regulations.
- 3. Only competitors with a competition number are permitted to be on the race circuit.
- 4. Each competitor must be equipped with a rigid helmet.
- 5. Each competitor receives 3 competition numbers: placed 1 on the hip and on 2 the shoulder.

VI COURSE AND RACE REGULATIONS

The race will be held on a circular route in accordance with UCI and PZKoI regulations. Lap length: 2 800 m.

















The race course will be available on 14.11.2025 (Friday) between 12:00 and 15:00 (with medical assistance). Schedule of start times, award ceremonies, and distances to be covered for each category:

- from 7:30 a.m. verification of licensed competitors at the race office
- from 8:00 a.m. verification of amateurs at the organizer office
- 8:00 8:45 training on the race circuit
- 9:00 Masters Men I category (35-44 years old) about 45 min.
- 9:01 Masters Men II category (45-54 years old) about 45 min.
- 9:02 Masters Men III category (55-64 years old) and Masters IV category (65 years +) about 35 min.
- 10:00 Youth Boys U-15 category about 20 min.
- 10:01 Youth Girls U-15 category about 20min.
- 10:02 Youth Boys and Girls U-13 category 1 lap.
- 10:30 Youth Boys U-17 category about 35 min.
- 10:31 Youth Girls U-17 category about 30 min.
- 10:32 Masters Women category (35 years +), Women's Amateur category (18 years +) about 30min.
- 11:15 Amateur Men category about 40 min.
- 12:00 12:25 training on the race circuit
- 12:05 (1th) award ceremony of the following categories: Youth Boys and Girls category (U-13, U-15, U-17), Masters (M+W), Amateur (M+W)
- 12:30 UCI Junior Men category about 40min.
- 12:32 UCI Junior Women category about 40min.
- 13:25 (2nd) award ceremony of the UCI categories: Junior (M), Junior (W)
- 13:30 UCI Women's Elite category (including U-23, Open) about 50min.
- 14:25 (3rd) award ceremony of the UCI categories: U-23 Women, Women's Elite
- 14:30 UCI Men's Elite category, U-23 (Open) about 60min.
- 15:40 (4th) award ceremony of the UCI categories: U-23 Men, Men's Elite.

VII FINANCING RULES

Organisational costs and the price money are covered by the organiser.

Travel and accommodation costs are covered by the participants.

Entry fees according to PZKol regulations.

Amateur category - entry fee 100 PLN, but 130 PLN after the deadline (from 13.11.2025).

VIII PRICES

The organiser provides financial and material prizes and medals for winners in individual age categories. The financial prize pool is in accordance with UCI and PZKol guidelines (in a separate attachment: OwocowyPrzelaj 2025 UCI C2 SuperPucharPL award list.pdf).

If the number of competitors registered in each category is declared to be too low, the organiser reserves the right to change the value of and number of prizes.

If licensed and amateur races take part in one race (women), the organiser will prepare separate prizes.

















IX JUDGING COMMITTEE

The PCP is Jorge García Rivas designated by the UCI.

The PZKol College of Judges has appointed 4 commissioners. The main judge from PZKol is Dawid Sobura.

The other judges were delegated in agreement with the organiser.

Medical care is provided by MED-SAR Training Assurance Rescue from Grudziadz, together with a doctor: Patryk Sobolewski.

XII FINAL PROVISIONS 2

Competitors take part at their own risk.

Competitors are required to wear a rigid helmet.

Competitors must be insured by their clubs, or in the case of Amateurs, insured individually.

The competitor must know his/her PESEL number, which is necessary to receive the prize, otherwise he will not

Any disputes are resolved by the chief judge in consultation with the organiser.

The organizer is not responsible for accidents caused by competitors or accompanying persons during the race.

The organiser will provide a designated bicycle washing station, a regeneration meal after the race, and medical support during the race.

The organiser is not responsible for items lost or stolen during the competition.

Competitors and guardians agree to the processing of personal data by the race office in accordance with the Journal of Laws (Dz. U.) 2018 item 1000 of 10.05.2018.
