****DATE AND VENUE:****

- The races will take place on November 16, 2025 (SUNDAY), on the grounds of the Central Sports Center "Cetniewo" in Władysławowo, Żeromskiego St. 52, and on the beach
- The race office will be open at the "Cetniewo" Center in Władysławowo on the day of the event from 8:00 AM

PARTICIPATION:

- The race will be held according to UCI and PZKol regulations.
- Competitors must have valid licenses for the year 2025. Current medical certificates are required for Polish athletes. Age categories valid for the 2025/26 cyclocross season apply.
- In the Amateur categories: Amateur I (men aged 18-35), Amateur II (men aged 36 and older), and Amateur Women OPEN (women aged 18 and older) – starting positions in the Amateur category will be determined by the order of registration.
- Male and female amateurs residing in Puck County should provide this information during registration for the Puck County Championship classification.
- All participants must wear a hard helmet and use a working bicycle in accordance with UCI and PZKol regulations for the given age categories. Amateurs may use a cyclocross or MTB bike.
- **PARKING** spaces are available only in designated areas for teams participating in the competition. Applications must be submitted by November 12, 2025, to klifklub@wp.pl. Please provide the car make, registration number, and, if there will be a tent, its dimensions.
- By agreeing to participate in the race, competitors accept all provisions of this regulation.

- Registrations and payments must be made according to PZKol regulations for the race by the "A" deadline of November 14, 2025 (Thursday) at 6:00 PM. (Fees: Żak Boys/Girls – 10 PLN, Młodzik Boys/Girls – 15 PLN, Junior Youth Boys/Girls – 20 PLN, Junior Boys/Girls – 50 PLN, Elite Men/Women – 80 PLN, U-23 Men/Women – 80 PLN, Masters Men/Women – 70 PLN, Amateur Men/Women – 70 PLN).
- Only competitors who have paid the entry fee correctly will be placed on the start list.
- Registration verification and race number distribution will take place on race day starting at 7:30 AM at the race office located at the "Cetniewo" Sports Center in Władysławowo.
- **SUPER WEEKEND:** 2x UCI C2 – Participants who declare participation in two races (Saturday and Sunday) will receive one race number for both events (November 15, 2025, Owocowy Przełaj in Laskowice Pomorskie and November 16, 2025, Dalej Na Północ Rowerem Się Nie Da in Władysławowo – Cetniewo).
- The start list for each age category closes 60 minutes before the race start.
- Competitors must return race numbers and chips to the race office after the event. A fee of 100 PLN will be charged for lost or damaged chips.

RACE PROGRAM

- 10:31 - Youth Girls U-17 category - about 30 min.
- 10:32 - Masters Women category (35 years +), Women's Amateur category (18 years +) - about 30min.
- 11:15 - Amateur Men category - about 40 min.
- 12:00 - 12:25 - training on the race circuit

FINANCIAL RULES

- Organizational costs are covered by the organizer.
- Travel and accommodation costs are borne by the delegating units.
- Registration fees follow PZKol regulations.
- Payments are made via www.wynikizawodow.eu during registration.
- The organizer can issue an invoice for the registration fee upon request.
- In case of withdrawal from the race by November 09, 2025, the entry fee will be refunded. After this date, no refunds will be provided.

PRIZES

- The organizer provides cash prizes in accordance with the regulations of the Polish Cycling Association.
- The total cash prize pool is 26 860 PLN.
- Material prizes worth 6,000 PLN.
- Podium winners must appear in their club sports attire.
- **IMPORTANT:** All cash prizes will be transferred to the bank accounts provided by the athletes after the decoration ceremony. Competitors must provide their bank details to the Race Office for the transfer of prize money.

Appendix No. 1 GDPR Clause

To fulfill the information obligation related to the processing of personal data, as per Article 13(1) and (2) of the Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation – hereinafter referred to as GDPR), we inform you that:

3. Legal basis for data processing: Article 6(1)(a) of the GDPR.
4. Data retention period: Data will be stored for the duration of the event or until consent is withdrawn. Data will not be kept longer than 5 years.
5. Participant's rights: a) You have the right to access your personal data, obtain a copy, rectify, amend, delete, limit processing, or object to the processing within the limits specified by law.
b) You have the right to withdraw your consent at any time by submitting a written statement to the data administrator's address. The withdrawal of consent does not affect the legality of the data processing carried out based on the consent before its withdrawal.
c) You have the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority if you believe that the processing of your personal data violates the provisions of the GDPR.
6. Providing your personal data is voluntary, but the consequence of not providing it may hinder or prevent participation in the race.
7. Data will not be subject to automated decision-making or profiling.
